

ADA Detectable Warning Color/Contrast **Bulletin:**

Colors used with Truncated Dome **Stamping System (02.08.08)**

In referencing the Draft Guidelines for Accessible Public Rights-of-Way, published in the Federal Register on Monday, June 17th, 2002 by the *U.S. Access Board*. The following contains information on the colors and contrasts to use in accordance with the ADA Detectable Warning Stamped concrete truncated Dome tools.

According to section **1108.1.3 Contrast** of the aforementioned article, detectable warning surfaces shall contrast visually with adjacent walking surfaces either light-on-dark, or dark-on-light.

The colors recommended for use would be any of the following:

- Dark Brown Integral Color
- Dark Gray Integral Color
- Brick Red Integral Color
- Dark Brown Color Hardener
- Dark Gray Color Hardener
- Brick Red Color Hardener

In addition, we suggest the curb ramps be sealed with the matching Colour-Seal pigmented Sealer.
